#### **ITEM 5 - REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY**

Those wishing to march with other groups are to bid for tickets from those groups. **Only RE ex-servicemen & women are permitted to march in the REA contingent.**
- 13. The Royal British Legion will only accept bids submitted through Regimental Association Headquarters and not direct to them by individuals. Bids are requested by **23**<sup>th</sup> **June 2023** to enable a consolidated bid to be submitted thereafter.
