

WOODEN CROSSES – THE SAGA

At a monthly Branch meeting, many years ago, Ian Smith, Deputy Chairman, requested on behalf of the Ripon Royal British Legion (RRBL) for assistance in placing Wooden Crosses for the fallen, buried in the Ripon Area. There were insufficient RRBL numbers for this task.

It was passed unanimously by the Ripon REA members.

Six (6) years later on, this will be the last service to the Fallen, by Ripon REA, because we have been informed that the RBL will only be supplying 200 crosses in 2023. We have laid **760** Wooden Crosses every year, when we have been allowed to, since we started.

We have received letters of Thanks from both the Canadian and Germany Embassies in London for recognising their fallen comrades. Local families have also contacted us with their thanks.

Branch members and their families have turned out, sometime in inclement weather, to carry out this labour of respect. We must not forget the pupils and staff of Sharow CE Primary School who placed 240 crosses on the cemetery, next to their school, each year. They have a short service and then it is "one Cross per Grave"! One grave had two because they were the grandsons of the Fallen. Thanks to all those involved.

It is hoped that RBL will be able to provide Wooden Crosses for Ripon's Fallen in the future because I know that Ripon REA will supply the teams to lay them. Kenn
